Market report for Thursday, October 17-We sold a total of 626 head of cows and bulls. We had quite a few pregged open cows and heifers that were even higher than the previous week. The pregged open heifers brought \$211-\$235, depending on weight. Young, wet bag cows were \$3-\$6 higher averaging \$168-\$199. Fleshy cows were \$3-\$4 higher averaging \$138.50-\$148.50. Cows in good shape that went on feed brought \$133.50-\$149, up to \$6.50 higher than last week. Lower yielding cows were higher yet, at \$5-\$6 more, averaging \$108.50-\$127, with most of them going on feed. We had a better test of bulls this week with them at \$130-\$158.50. We had a lot of participation with 8 cow buyers in the seats. Thank you to the buyers and sellers for all you do. Overall, a really good sale and with a strong demand for feeding cows, the prices should keep increasing.
